

RING PRIVACY POLICY

Welcome to the Privacy Policy for <https://www.ringtx.com> (“**Privacy Policy**”) provided by Ring Therapeutics, Inc. (“**Ring**,” “**we**” or “**us**”). This Privacy Policy describes how we collect, use and disclose information about you (“**Information**”) related to your use of and access to the Ring sites, content, applications, services, tools and features, provided by us, including without limitation, the website <https://www.ringtx.com> (the “**Website**”). Please read this Privacy Policy carefully. For purposes of this Privacy Policy, “**you**” and “**your**” means you as the user of the Website.

1. TYPES OF INFORMATION WE COLLECT

When you use the Website, we may collect Information in the following categories:

- “**Personal Information**,” which means Information that identifies you (whether directly or indirectly), such as your name, postal address, email address and telephone number.
- “**Non-Personal Information**,” which means Information that does not directly or indirectly identify, and cannot reasonably be used to identify you. If Non-Personal Information is directly or indirectly associated with Personal Information, this Non-Personal Information is then treated as Personal Information.

The Information we may collect about you includes:

- Information you provide when you access or use the Website and each time you interact with the Website or otherwise with us, for example, when you contact us with a question or comment.
- Usage, viewing and technical data, including your IP address or device identifier when you use the Website. If you access your account from a mobile device, that mobile device may also provide us with details of your location. Most mobile devices allow you to disable this functionality.
- Information we receive about you from third parties. For example, if you access the Website through a third-party platform or log-in, we may also collect your email address and other Information associated with that third party, and any Information you have made public in connection with that service or which the third party shares with partner services. See also Section 6 “**THIRD PARTY WEBSITES AND LINKS**” below.

2. HOW WE COLLECT YOUR INFORMATION

- We collect Information you provide to us when you input Information into the Website, request information from us, email us about general inquiries or otherwise interact with us or the Website. This Information may include Personal Information you provide such as your name, email address and telephone number.
- We collect Information through unique identifiers (such as your IP address).

Online Tracking

- Do Not Track (DNT) is a privacy preference that users can set in some web browsers, allowing users to opt out of tracking by websites and online services. Ring and the Website do not recognize DNT.

3. USE OF YOUR INFORMATION BY RING

The ways in which we may use your Information include the following:

- To provide you with the Website and other services you request.
- To send you details or updates about features of the Website or changes to our policies.
- To create anonymized and aggregated data sets that may be used for a variety of functions, including research, internal analysis, analytics or other functions.
- To ensure consistency with local law and choices and controls that may be available to you.
- To personalize content and experiences.
- To detect, investigate and prevent activities that may violate our policies or be illegal.
- To optimize or improve the content, services and features of the Website.
- To personalize and improve the Website and user experiences, to increase the functionality and user friendliness of the Website or to deliver content or features that match user profiles or interests.
- To monitor and analyze the Website usage and trends and otherwise measure the effectiveness of the Website.

4. SHARING YOUR INFORMATION WITH OTHER COMPANIES

We will only share your Personal Information outside Ring in the following limited circumstances, which you consent to:

- When you allow us to share your Personal Information with another company (i.e., directing us to share your Personal Information with third-party sites or platforms, such as social networking sites). If you use third-party sites or platforms made available through the Website (e.g., Facebook logon), those third parties will have access to your data to the extent that you have authorized their access. Please consult Section 6 “THIRD PARTY WEBSITE S AND LINKS” below and the third party’s privacy policy for additional information.
- When we contract or partner with a third party to provide services on our behalf, which we do for Website development and maintenance. We require all third parties to process your data in accordance with this Privacy Policy and as permitted by applicable data protection laws.
- In connection with the sale of a business (including merger, acquisition, or sale of all or a material portion of its assets, change in corporate control or insolvency or bankruptcy proceedings).

- To enforce our terms of service or rules; to ensure the safety and security of our users and third parties; to protect our rights and property and the rights and property of our users and third parties; or to comply with legal process, including judicial warrant, rule, order or subpoena or in other cases if we believe in good faith that disclosure is required by law or regulation.

In addition, we may share Non-Personal Information and anonymized and aggregated data sets with third parties, alone or in combination with the Non-Personal Information of other users.

5. YOUR CONTROLS AND CHOICES

We provide you the ability to exercise certain controls and choices regarding our collection, use and sharing of your Information. Your controls and choices may include:

- You may change your choices for alerts.
- You may request access to the Personal Information we hold about you and that we amend or delete it.

You may exercise your controls and choices, or request access to your Personal Information, contacting us at finance@ringtx.com or following instructions provided in communications sent to you. Please be aware that if you do not allow us to collect Personal Information from you, we may not be able to deliver certain services to you and some of our services may not be able to take account of your interests and preferences. 6. THIRD PARTY WEBSITES AND LINKS

Our Website may contain links to other sites or online platforms operated by third parties as well as embedded content (e.g. videos, images, articles, etc.). Please keep in mind that Information you post on public or semi-public venues, including Information you share on third-party social networking platforms (such as Facebook or Twitter) may also be viewable by other users of the Website and/or users of those third-party online platforms without limitation as to its use by us or by a third-party. When you provide Information to a third-party online platform, the Information you provide may be separately collected by that third-party. The Information the third-party online platform collects is subject to the third-party online platform’s privacy practices. Privacy choices you make on the third-party online platform will not apply to our use of the Information we collect directly through our Website.

We expressly disclaim any and all liability for the actions of third parties, including but without limitation to actions relating to the use and/or disclosure of Personal Information by third parties.

7. CHILDREN'S PRIVACY

We do not seek or knowingly collect any Personal Information about children under 13 years of age. If we become aware that we have unknowingly collected Personal Information from a child 13 years of age or younger, we will make commercially reasonable efforts to delete such Information from our database.

If you are the parent or guardian of a child under 13 years of age who has provided us with Personal Information, you may contact us to request it be deleted.

8. DATA SECURITY, INTEGRITY AND RETENTION

Please note that Information you send to us electronically may not be secure when it is transmitted to us. We recommend that you do not use unsecure channels to communicate sensitive or confidential Information to us. From time to time, we review our security procedures to consider appropriate new technology and methods. Please be aware though that, despite our best efforts, no security measures are perfect or impenetrable. We will retain your Personal Information for the length of time needed to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy unless a longer retention period is required, or for the establishment, exercise or defense of legal claims, or for legitimate businesses purposes, or as provided by law.

9. UPDATING THIS PRIVACY POLICY

We may modify this Privacy Policy from time to time in which case we will update the "Last Revised" date at the top of this Privacy Policy. If we make changes that are material, we will use reasonable efforts to attempt to provide notice to you and, where required by applicable law, we will obtain your consent. Notice may be by email to you at the last email address you provided us, by posting notice of such changes on the Website or by other means, consistent with applicable law. However, it is your sole responsibility to review the Privacy Policy from time to time to view any such changes. The updated Privacy Policy will be effective as of the time of posting, or such later date as may be specified in the updated Privacy Policy. **IF YOU DO NOT ACCEPT AND AGREE TO THIS PRIVACY POLICY, INCLUDING ANY CHANGES, THEN YOU MUST NOT ACCESS OR USE THE WEBSITE.**
